TRUMP LEADS – WHEN

• Dummy has a Ruffing Value

- direct raise as dummy likely has some shortness
- declarer has shown 2 suits
- you have a stack in declarer's non-trump suit
- dummy has splintered showing a singleton
- dummy has bid Trash Stayman indicating a Stiff Club

• Opponents have a True Preference Auction

- it shows true support (not a false preference)
- you have a stack in declarer's non-trump suit

• Opponents have Enough Strength to Show Their Hands

- a preference in a strong bidding sequence shows true support

Partner Has Opened 1NT

- you & partner have most of the high cards
- opponents will need crossruffs to make the hand
- opponent has shown a 2-suited hand & will need to do some ruffs

After a Conventional Bid by the Opponents

- Michaels or Unusual
- Responder seems unhappy in his preference
- you have a stack in the convention bidder's non-trump suit_
- looks like partner may have a stack in the convention bidder's non-trump suit

Partner Passes your Takeout Double

- he has 5-6 very strong trumps & wants to pull declarer's trumps, so lead your stiff trump
- Other Leads are Terrible

DON'T LEAD TRUMPS - If

- You have a Singleton may damage partner's trump holding
- May Endanger a Potential Trump Trick
 - you have 2 or 3 trumps to the 10 or J (even 9xx can cost)
- Suspect Dummy has a Side Good Suit to Dump Losers lead aggressively
- Their Bidding Suggests Strength & Tricks lead aggressively
